Ph.D. student seminar co-located with NISK 18/11-20/11

Decision: UiS (Chunming Rong and Aryan TaheriMonfared) organises a student seminar colocated with NISK. The seminar starts Wednesday after lunch, includes an overnight stay and concludes on Thursday so that all participants can be home Thursday night. COINS AMO informs about the working format of the SWITS seminar and offers to organise a study tour to the MyPhD workshop in Germany that addresses a similar group (Ph.D. students in IT security). COINS supports the seminar financially with kr. 10 000 to cover direct costs, e.g. an invited speaker. The goal is to have as many COINS students participate as possible, ideally also to have them stay for NISK before the seminar. COINS covers travel costs for participating students, based on simple accommodation (e.g. youth hostel or double rooms) so that the budget can cover many participants. COINS invites up to four Ph.D. students from SWITS to foster Norwegian-Swedish network building.

Action item: Chunming Rong informs Aryan TaheriMonfared about the decision and shepherds the organisation of the seminar.

Metochi summer school 2014

Decision: UiA (Vladimir Oleshchuk) develops a proposal for a summer school to be held at the Metochi study centre in 2014, if possible with a visit to ENISA as part of the school. COINS reserves kr. 300 000 in the budget proposal for 2014 to cover accommodation for 20 people and travel costs for 15 students and 5 lecturers. The summer school should be relevant for many Ph.D. students in information security, possibly open for (paying) participants outside of COINS. Participation in the summer school should be credited towards the training component of the Ph.D. programmes of the consortium members. A proposal will be discussed at the next SC meeting.

Action item: Vladimir Oleshchuk develops a proposal for the Metochi summer school in 2014 for the next SC meeting.

Common course descriptions

Budget

Activities in 2013 will focus on participation in the Finse winter school (April 2013, done), student mobility (assembling all students at NISK, maybe send some to NordSec), having a CTF Capture the Flag team with students from COINS and SWITS, and a student seminar co-located with NISK.

Decision: The budget for 2013 is accepted as proposed and the budget proposal for 2014 is noted.

Miscellaneous

Decision: The next SC meeting takes place on Thursday 2013-08-15 from 15:00-16:30 hrs., preferably as a video conference.

Decision: The Research Council of Norway may distribute the COINS consortium agreement to other research schools.
